The survey was conducted with **Adolescence group** , around **20,000 Students** of different schools and educational institutions were contacted and counseled by volunteers and psychologist of the organization on the spot . The masses were educated on the issues of Mental Health and General Well being , and related taboo & stigma to mental health in the society .

The survey was conducted as a pilot project initially in two district (Shimla & Solan) and adolescent of aged between 13 to 18 years were counseled on mental health , stress , depression , career , drug abuse and varies issues . Survey included a psychometric test (Provided by Psychology deptt) & awareness questionnaires (black blanket own) .

The survey was conducted both in urban and rural areas of different geographical , social and financial areas of the district .Volunteers of the orgnisation visited city as well as outskirts and remote areas to reach each and every school so that the awareness level can be checked .

Half Way Home

(Under Department of Social Justice and Empowerment Himachal Pradesh)

Our Aasra Half Way Home for psycho-social rehabilitation of treated and controlled mentally ill patients is fully operational at Kunihar Distt. Solan. Organization is successfully completed almost four years in rehabilitation of mentally ill cured patients and having more than satisfactory results of recovery of patients . At present 24 beneficiaries are getting rehabilitation services ie food /lodging, medical treatment and life skill activities at kunihar campus .

Dealing with mental hospital . since the patients discharged from the mental hospital: Boilujang and all their treatment and follow up is running from the mental hospital society has made every possible effort to get medicine on time. The patients requiring follow up from the government psychiatrist is arranged whenever possible at mental hospital or IGMC .

Disability certificate. Since the patients coming from the mental hospital doesn't had disability certificate the society has managed to arrange their disability certificate by dealing with different government departments.

Bank accounts. To get the benefits of schemes run by government it was essential to have bank accounts since the patients were homeless with no proper identity society has made all efforts to make their AADHAR cards and identity proofs so that bank accounts can be opened.

Finding home and relatives of homeless missing patients:

In our half way home we come across patients who were missing and not in conditions to communicate properly about their where about. we spent time with them patiently with care and love tried communicating with them and gathered information , with use of technology ,goggle translator , AADHAR etc we succeed to find some of the patients original name and address , tried communicating with concerned police stations with hundreds of mails , letters and local contact finally got eight patients address.

Campaign on female safety and drug free community

Origation has supported people working voluntarily for awareness of female safety and drug free community in local wards of shimla with the help of members at local ward bodies at kainthu , and shil sanjuli and other wards of shimla .

Modus Operandi: Our 3-Step Candidate Success Framework

While we counsel our potential trainers we emphasize on motivating them how this training is their best chance for not just getting a better job but also starting their businesses or becoming an entrepreneur.



We counsel our students through a 3-step procedure, which is as follows:

- 1. Creating a career trajectory plan:** Our plan includes precise direction on the steps the candidates must take to reach his/her goals. Being involved in the goal-setting process helps us win their confidence, which makes them believe in our advise.
- 2. Motivation:** Motivation is an ongoing process hence we regularly interact and follow-up with the candidates to assess, motivate and encourage the students all through. If a candidate fall behind, we get him or her motivated and re-energized by reminding them their aspiration sand working towards achieving them.
- 3. Helping them stay calm and focused:** Career-related decision scan cause turbulence in a candidate's life in the form of anxiety and worry. This can again demotivate students. Helping them stay calm and focused while maintaining a positive attitude through out will help students gain confidence.

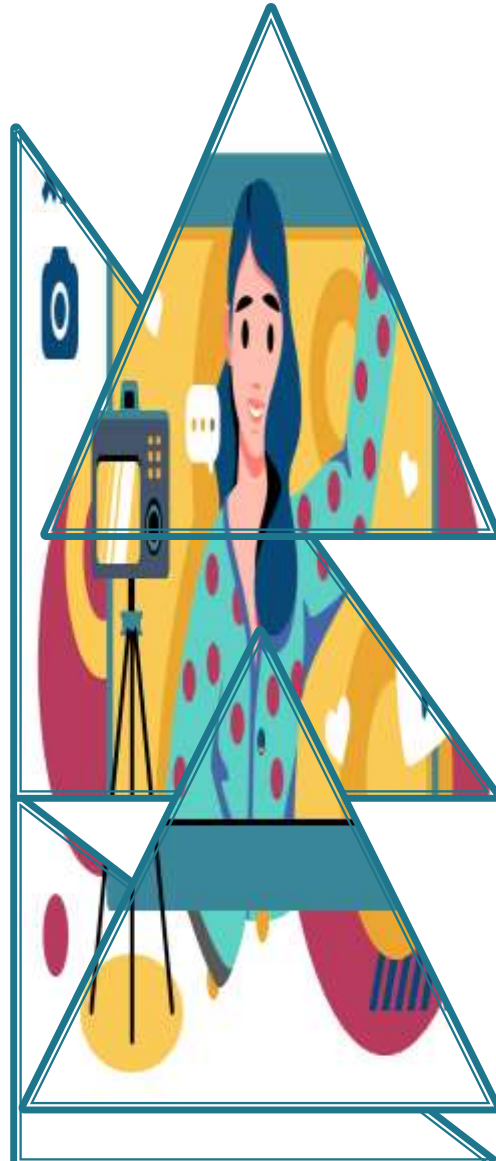

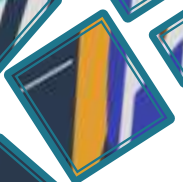
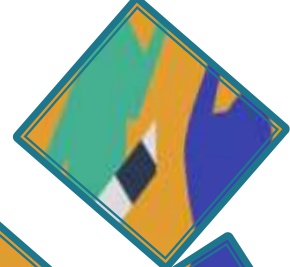
